Some of the Workshops in the Gullinyjas Project include: Alcohol & Other Drugs, Domestic Violence, Mental Health, Legal Advocacy, Cultural Identity, Cooking and even a Pamper Day.

Where will the Gullinyjas Project be held?

Nelly's Healing Aboriginal Corporation at the Yallamunid Building, 145 Cleveland Street, Darlington.

Childcare is not available throughout the Gullinyjas Project, so be sure to arrange childcare for a few hours each Thursday for the duration. Morning and afternoon tea will be provided.

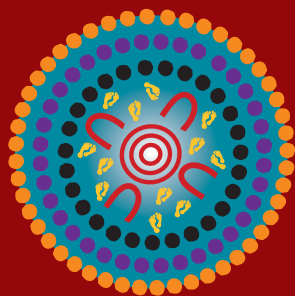
Who is Nelly's Healing Aboriginal Corporation?

We educate and support Aboriginal women who are scarred and affected by intergenerational trauma. Nelly's Healing Aboriginal Corporation was founded by Helen Eason, a Gomeri and Biripi woman who has lived experience of these systems.
